Fostering Healthy Communities through Family Learning: Invitation to join the Health@Home final conference.

Meath Partnership would like to invite interested educators and practitioners to join a 2-hour online conference on the **23.09.2021 at 10am** (IST). The conference will focus on how we can continue to foster healthy communities using family learning.

The key note speaker for this conference is **Professor Ester Prins**, Lifelong Learning and Adult Education, Penn State, US. Prof. Prins is the co-author of Teaching and Learning and Family Literacy and Family Literacy Programs (in press, Routledge). She also serves as the Co-Director of the Goodling Institute for Research in Family Literacy and the Institute for the Study of Adult Literacy. At the Conference, Prof. Prins will share her insights on health literacy and on learning with families after a pandemic.

In addition, participants will have an opportunity to hear from **Mary Flanagan**, Coordinator of Family Learning Work at Limerick and Clare Education and Training Board who will be sharing her insights on the topic of fostering healthy communities.

As part of the Health@Home project, a **bespoke suite of resources** has been developed to support families, educators and practitioners to embed family learning into their everyday practice. All participants will have the opportunity to avail of free resource packs (both hardcopy and softcopy available).

The conference will be delivered by the Health@Home consortium which includes five family learning organisations based in Ireland, the United Kingdom, Portugal, Spain and Cyprus.
