

## Lucky Lucky! and The dog's dinner

### Story cards

#### Preparation

- Print, laminate and cut out the story cards, one set for each group

#### Instructions

This game can be played by any number of players. At least 6 make it more exciting! The learners will determine the level. It also allows for mixed levels within the group.

The object of the game is to compose a group story. The story can be as unlikely and fantastic as they want - that adds to the fun!

If the group is not very large, learners can pick up two or more cards each before finishing the story.

1. Discuss how a story begins in e.g. *Once upon a time*, or *One day...*
2. Put the cards in one pile, face down, on the table.
3. Each player takes it in turns to pick up a card.
4. The first player begins with *Once upon a time* or *One day ...* and makes up a sentence about the picture on their card while showing it to the rest of the group.
5. The next person makes up a sentence about the picture on their card, linking it to the sentence that went before, showing the picture as they speak.
6. Continue round the group until someone decides to end the story.
